

This past school year I served as the Black Law Students Association President for SLU Law. In these leadership roles I have learned the value of team work, proper planning, and being receptive to different ideas and perspectives. As the Law Student Division's Delegate of Communications I will use these experiences to provide collaborative leadership and accountability as we find ways to reach more law students and build more bridges.
