Application Details

To be eligible for certification as a candidate, you must complete the online application form in its entirety, attaching this certification and the items below by the given deadline. No late or incomplete applications will be accepted under any circumstances.

1) Certification form signed by any dean of your law school (PDF File #1).

- The Certification Form must contain your signature and the signature of your dean and must be signed and submitted electronically.

2) Statement and resume (PDF File #2).

- Statement and resume combined must not exceed three single-sided, 8.5" x 11" pages.
- Any statement, resume or combination of statement and resume in excess of the three page limit will be truncated after the third page.

3) Candidate headshot.

- JPG or PNG
- Less than 16MB
- 300 x 300px

4) OPTIONAL: Video statement link, hosted on a publicly available web platform.

- Five minutes maximum time limit.
- All video statements should discuss candidate qualifications and platform.
- Only the candidate can appear in the video statement.
- The video statement content must be of a professional nature.
- All video statements must adhere to copyright laws. No music is permitted.
- The video content cannot violate any provisions of the Elections Code.
- The Elections Committee will reject any video statements that violate these guidelines or the spirit of these guidelines
