



Competitions Championship Points System

To determine the ABA Competitions Champion, points will be awarded for participation and awards earned in the Arbitration, Client Counseling, National Appellate Advocacy, and Negotiation Competitions.

Participation Points

One point will be awarded for each team that participates in a competition. Two additional points will be awarded to each school that participates in three of the four competitions. One additional point will be awarded to each school that participates in all four competitions.
